


MELODY MANOR & COUNTRY MANOR PERSONAL CARE HOMES AERIAL MAP








MELODY MANOR & COUNTRY MANOR PERSONAL CARE HOMES SITE MAP





MELODY MANOR & COUNTRY MANOR PERSONAL CARE HOMES FLOOR PLAN

MELODY MANOR—Cooper Side



COUNTRY MANOR





Kittanning is a borough and the county seat of Armstrong County in Pennsylvania. It is approximately 44 miles northeast of Pittsburgh.

The borough is located on the east bank of the Allegheny River, founded on the site of the eighteenth-century Native American village of Kittanning at the western end of the Kittanning Path.

Early in the 20th century, it had large iron and steel works, foundries, coal mines, glass-works, flour and lumber mills, china, pottery, brick, lime, and clay works, mirror and typewriter factories, breweries, etc.

According to the United States Census Bureau, the borough has a total area of approximately 1.0 square mile of which all is land.

Armstrong County is located in the southwestern part of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

The county was organized on March 12, 1800 from parts of Allegheny, Westmoreland and Lycoming Counties.

Armstrong County is included in the Pittsburgh, PA Metropolitan Statistical Area.




